REGISTERED NURSE I (RN I)

Minimum Requirements:

- A license to practice as a Registered Nurse issued by the California Board of Registered Nursing
- A valid California Class C Driver License
- Currently hold the payroll title of a RN I (lateral transfer) or on a reachable RN I list

Essential Job Functions:

- Perform comprehensive Refugee Health Nursing Intake Assessment (RHNIA) per protocol
- Assist clinician in the nursing care of Refugee clients' physical evaluations
- Performs a range of nursing tasks required by the service, such as phlebotomy, specimen collection and processing; administering medications/injections and immunizations; client health assessment interviews and data collections; conduct comprehensive interviews and case management of Refugees and Asylees; navigate client care and referrals
- Completes appropriate paperwork such as logs, report, and forms
- Nurse visit/triage unscheduled clients
- Consult with clinician on medical management issues
- Ensures the maintenance of emergency cart, pharmacy, and clinic supplies
- Review's laboratory results and refers abnormal results to clinician
- Assists in monitoring quality assurance, infection control and safety activities
- May coordinate the patient's medical care with private physicians, public facilities and other health care centers
- Willing to commute and work in various clinics, when needed

Desirable Qualifications:

- Experience in performing comprehensive RHNIA
- Strong knowledge in pediatric and adult immunizations schedules
- Strong communication and leadership skills
- Computer literate
- Flexible and able to work independently
- Bilingual Skills (Spanish, Farsi, Russian, Armenian)
