REGISTERED NURSE I

Under the direction of the Clinic Nurse Supervisor, the Registered Nurse I (RN I) will perform professional nursing duties for complex patients and is proficient in all areas of clinic operations and management. The RN I will identify patients' needs as they progress across the continuum and develop effective relationships with the health care team and community. The RN I will incorporate evidence-based practice, including current research and literature, consensus statements, community standards, and recommendations from professional organizations into nursing practice. The RN I may lead nurses, have responsibility and operational leadership and coordination of several services and is also responsible for organizing implementing and evaluating community outreach clinics.

JOB DUTIES:

- Appropriately identifies population-specific client care needs during initial and ongoing assessments
- Reviews and validates all assessment data to appropriately identify and analyze client's condition to prioritize and determine care and interventions
- Accurately documents all pertinent information during the planning stages in accordance with departmental documentation policies and procedures
- Coordinates the client's medical care with private physicians, public facilities, and other health centers as needed.
- Collaborate with a multidisciplinary team to meet the needs of the client
- Monitors the quality of nursing care through observation of staff performance and chart audits; makes corrective, constructive recommendations
- Performs duties and responsibilities as established by the Department

MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS:

- A license to practice as a Registered Nurse issued by the California Board of Registered Nursing and a valid California Class C Driver License.
- Currently hold the payroll title of a RN I (lateral transfer) or on a current RN I certification list

DESIRABLE QUALIFICATIONS:

- Strong interpersonal and problem-solving skills
- Bilingual Skills (Spanish, Mandarin, Cantonese or Vietnamese)
- Self-motivated, reliable, independent, organized and flexible
- Ability to facilitate meetings and lead groups
