PUBLIC HEALTH NURSE

The Tuberculosis Control Program (TBCP) is seeking a Public Health Nurse to act as a liaison between TBCP, Community Health Services and County correctional facilities. PHN duties include: 1) assessing, evaluating and monitoring the health status of incarcerated TB suspects and cases through direct patient interview and chart review; 2) consultation and collaboration to promote continuity of care once released from a County correctional facility to district health center for continued management; 3) health teaching; 4) participating in process and outcome evaluation by monitoring identified nursing interventions or services.

Minimum Qualifications:

- Valid CA RN License
- PHN certificate
- Hold the payroll title of PHN or must be on a reachable Public Health Nurse Certification List
- Valid Driver's License

Desired Qualifications:

- Experience as a Public Health Nurse
- Desire to work with a diverse population
- Strong knowledge of tuberculosis transmission principles, pathophysiology, and treatment standards
- Experience and ability to work with all levels of professional staff and community partners
