PUBLIC HEALTH NURSE

The PHN functions under the direction of a Program Specialist in the Education and Evaluation Unit. This position will evaluate TB screening services provided and serve as a liaison/resource person between the TBCP and the Community/Private sector providers to improve LTBI treatment initiation and completion outcomes.

Essential Job Functions

- Assess, evaluate, and monitor data and trends regarding targeted groups at risk for TB infection/disease.
- Provide consultation and collaborate with various medical providers on TB screening, care and prevention.
- Provides/Coordinates TB education, screening and outreach activities with community medical providers.
- Collaborate with private/community providers to encourage: use of California immunization registry for documentation of TB screening results and to initiate treatment for latent TB infection per local guidelines.
- Assists in developing TB related performance improvement projects regarding TB infection treatment initiation and completion.
- Provides support for TBCP education and training for public and private sector providers and contact investigation activities for high risk populations in the community.

Minimum Requirements:

Must currently be a permanent Los Angeles County employee who holds the payroll item of Public Health Nurse.

- Public Health Nursing field experience
- Knowledge of HIV, latent TB infection and tuberculosis disease
- Effective problem solving and analytical skills
- Outstanding written and verbal communication skills
- Previous experience developing and conducting presentations
- Strong organization and Customer service skills
- Ability to create an action plan and prioritize duties
- Ability to perform effectively and independently
- Experience working with community partners
- Proficiency in Microsoft Office
