PUBLIC HEALTH NURSE

The Los Angeles County, Tuberculosis Control Program (TBCP) is recruiting to fill one (1) Public Health Nurse (PHN) position. The PHN functions under the direction of the Education and Evaluation Unit Program Specialist, PHN. Employee parking is provided.

Essential Job Functions

- Coordinates the TB education, screening and outreach activities for Community-Based Organizations and community providers. Outreach will be a team activity and includes Grupo sites where clients are primarily Spanish-speaking.
- Educate and ensure community based providers refer for initiation treatment for latent TB infection as appropriate per local guidelines.
- Assists in outbreak response activities as part of a team.
- Provides TBCP education and training activities for high risk populations in the community.
- Documents and responds to calls and inquiries related to TB and TB services from the public.
- Reviews new and ongoing genotype linked cases identified by the California State TB Control Branch as a cluster.
- Serves as a student nurse orientation coordinator.
- May travel from the TBC headquarters office to any district public health center sites and other community based organizations, as needed.

Minimum Requirements:

Must currently be a permanent Los Angeles County employee who holds the payroll item of Public Health Nurse.

Desired Qualifications:

- Bilingual Spanish speaking
- Minimum of 2yrs. District Public Health Nursing field experience with TB case management and contact investigations.
- Effective problem solving and analytical skills, and ability to perform duties independently
- Strong organization and customer service skills, and ability to prioritize duties
- Experience working with community partners
- Computer skills: MS Word, MS Excel, MS Power point
