Request for Initiatives (RFI)

**PLACE Program solicits proposals from:
cities, community-based organizations,
schools, and for-profit organizations
in Los Angeles County**

Grantees will work to improve the built environment (i.e. streets, parks, transportation, etc.) and increase levels of physical activity among community residents by:

- Pursuing **policy changes** (i.e. community design, land use, zoning, street standards, general plans, etc.)
- Pursuing **physical projects** (i.e. bike lanes, sidewalks, trails, traffic calming, green space, etc.)
