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OVERVIEW & PURPOSE

PROMOTING MOTORCYCLE SAFETY

Motorcycle safety is a year-round priority, not just during awareness months. With fewer protective barriers than cars, motorcyclists face a higher risk of serious injury or death in collisions. By promoting responsible riding habits, proper protective gear, and continuous skills training, we can help reduce motorcycle-related injuries and fatalities on Los Angeles County roads.

This toolkit provides ready-to-use content to raise awareness, educate riders, and promote safe riding practices across social media platforms. Whether you're sharing safety tips, class opportunities, or gear reminders, these messages can help protect lives.

HOW TO USE TOOLKIT

This toolkit was created to help spread life-saving messages about motorcycle safety across social media platforms. Use the content as-is, or customize it to better fit your audience and voice.

Consider using this content during key awareness dates such as Motorcycle Safety Month in May and National Ride to Work Day on the second Tuesday in June to maximize impact and reach when public attention on rider safety is at its peak.

TOOLKIT GOALS

Promote safe riding habits through education on gear, skills, and decision-making.

Reduce injuries and fatalities by raising awareness about the risks of impaired or distracted riding.

Support community outreach that encourages shared responsibility between riders and drivers on the road.

BEST FOR COMMUNTIY ENGAGEMENT

These posts typically have static images, videos with captions.



INSTAGRAM

BEST FOR VISUAL STORYTELLING

These posts include reels (short-form videos), carousels, or stories.



X/TWITTER

BEST FOR TIMELY UPDATES

These posts are short and typically include hashtags.

Note:

When using these social media platforms, follow the **Engage**, **Tag**, and **Hashtag** strategy to maximize reach and interaction.

- Encourage interaction with your posts
- Tag key agencies (@OTS_CA, @CHP_HQ, @LAPublicHealth, and @ChooseHealthLA
- Use 2-4 relevant hashtags from the toolkit

legs in heavy duty clothing
designed for motorcycle riding,
wear sturdy boots that cover your
ankles, and don't forget gloves to
protect your hands and provide a
better grip.
