Potpourri of Reminders

Required Demographic Fields

- To support County and DHCS reporting requirements, SAPC made additional fields required upon admission.
 - Primary or Preferred Language
 - Date of Birth
 - Ethnic Origin
 - Client Race
 - Gender Identity
 - Sexual Orientation
- Additionally, we are working to require Address, Place of Birth, Country of Origin, Education, Employment Status, Marital Status and Veteran Status.

Admission Diagnosis

- Each record MUST have an Admission diagnosis on file as the Type of Diagnosis.
- The system will deny claims as "Eligibility Not Found/Verified in CalPM" if a valid Admission diagnosis is not present.

County and Aid Code Report

- The County and Aid Code Report has been updated to include the following eligibility information:
 - Managed Care Plan (MCP) and MCP Partner
 - Date range of eligibility that was returned on the 271.





Progress Note Updates

- Travel Time section changed to Field Based Services.
- Only enabled when the method of delivery is Field Based Services.

Potpourri of Reminders

Women's Health History

- Form is required for all PPW-Perinatal patients from notice of pregnancy through 1 year post partum.
- Expected Due Date field removed as it was deemed unnecessary for billing and caused issues when not completed.
- Only one Assessment record is required per pregnancy per agency.
- When updating a record, select "Edit" not "Add".

ASAM CO-Triage

- To ensure the CO-Triage correctly saves in Sage, always click the "Refresh ASAM Information" button on the top of the form after completing the questions.
- SUD Counselors can and should finalize the CO-Triage once completed in Sage.
- An LPHA IS NOT required to finalize the CO-Triage per SAPC or Medi-Cal guidelines as it is a preliminary SUD screener and does not provide a diagnosis.

- Update license information for better tracking

- List of practitioner status for each agency according to Sage data.
- Sent a list of Sage data to providers to confirm and update

When

- Sent Oct 13
- Was due by Oct 31. Please submit ASAP if you have not done so already.



Bi-Annual License Verification: Results by Category: Since 10/13/2025







Additional Noteworthy Findings

2 practitioners with services delivered after certification expiration date

31 changes to practitioner license (i.e. registered to certified, LE-LPHA to LPHA)

= PotentialBilling/AuditIssues

99 general modifications to either credential or user role (i.e. different type of registration or certification for SUD counselor, RAC to RADT or SUDRC for example)


Majority of license dates in Sage are out of date due to expiration dates not being updated after initial onboarding





Where are We Going Next:

- ➤ Working to integrate NACA data with Sage data for improved user experience and more pre-populated data in NACA
- > New *Practitioner Credentials Status widget* to be populated with the re-verification data received from providers
 - \succ All new practitioners onboarded since 10/1/2025 have been entered into the system with information from user creation form.
 - > Each provider will see the most up to date Sage information for their practitioners.
 - > Expiration Date and Status column will flag expired credentials.
 - > Includes practitioners with Sage accounts and Credential Only user groups.





☐ Replacement Claim Assignment form performance issues:

Resolution has been identified by Netsmart and is currently being tested in QA before release.



☐ Progress Notes in Draft- 1 month widget-

Performance issues have been resolved for most users. If you are still experiencing timeouts, create a Help Desk ticket and email sage@ph.lacounty.gov with the ticket number.






Sage Enhancements

Women's Health History- Last 3 Months Widget

- New Widget to help providers track when the Women's Health History form is complete or missing information.
- The form is required for all PPW-Perinatal clients to ensure claims to DMC indicate the client's pregnancy status.
- Incomplete or missing forms will result in state denials.
- Logic is based on clients with an approved PPW-Perinatal auth within the last 3 months (from current date) and a Women's Health History form Assessment Date within the last 365 days.








Sage Enhancements



- 1. County and Aid Code report updates
 - MCP information
 - Corresponding
 Eligibility period



- 2. Practitioner License/
 Registration/Certification
 Status Widget
 - New Widget to help track credential dates and Sage configuration.
 - Instructions for use will be sent in a provider communication



- 3. Document Printout Reports
 - Search the word
 "Printout" in the search
 bar to show current
 printouts available.
 - Used to easily print records for a cohesive medical record.
