9:30 – 10:00 Welcome and Overview of LA SBIRT Network

10:00 – 11:00 Emerging Issues and Trends in Addiction– Timothy Fong, MD

This session will cover recent events in the field of addiction treatment and research. First, an overview of the changes to the DSM-5 diagnostic criteria for substance use disorders will be conducted to provide an understanding of how a diagnosis of addiction is made. Second, trends in alcohol and drug use will be presented, with an emphasis on describing common and not-so common clinical scenarios where substance use disorders may arise. Finally, special attention will be paid to local trends in Los Angeles and California.

11:00 – 12:00 Research Perspectives on SBIRT – Suzette Glasner Edwards, PhD

This session will provide an overview of current scientific and empirical research conducted on SBIRT practices. Emphasis will be placed on discussing how impactful, effective SBIRT has been. Dr. Edwards will also describe a current SBIRT research protocol and how findings from research can be translated into clinical practice

12:00 – 1:30 Lunch and Provider Showcase

1:30 – 2:30 Using SBIRT in the Real World (Patricia Lester, MD)

Dr. Lester and the UCLA Division of Behavioral Health will describe and showcase how they have spearheaded a project to implement SBIRT practices inside a primary care setting. They will describe precise steps on how this was accomplished and how they addressed barriers, both expected and unexpected.

2:45– 4:00 Expert Panel on the State of Addiction Treatment: “Ask Anything”

A UCLA-led panel of addiction treatment and research experts will address and answer questions and topics related to addiction treatment and research. Topics such as medication management in recovery, breaking down barriers to treatment, marijuana legalization, dealing with prescription opiate abuse in primary care and translating research findings into practical solutions for patients and family will be discussed.
