

# Unflavored Tobacco List

## Quick Reference Guide

On December 31, 2025, the California Department of Justice published an Unflavored Tobacco List (UTL). The UTL includes tobacco products that are considered unflavored and can legally be sold in California, including unincorporated areas of Los Angeles County. Tobacco products that are not listed on the UTL are **not permitted** to be sold.

Effective January 1, 2026, the UTL is enforceable in unincorporated Los Angeles County. The following steps provide information on how to use the UTL to search for tobacco products.

### 1 Go to the UTL website

### 2 Search for the product

Type the UPC barcode number, brand, or product name in the search box. Click "Search."

### 3 Check the results



If the tobacco product is listed, the product can be legally sold.

If the tobacco product is not listed ("No products found."), the product **cannot** be legally sold.

The following tobacco products are exempt by the state flavor ban and are not required to be listed on the Unflavored Tobacco List:



Loose-leaf Pipe Tobacco\*



Shisha (Hookah)\*



Premium Cigars\*  
(with a wholesale price of \$12 or more)

◀ **NOTICE:** These exemptions **do not** apply to tobacco retailers operating in unincorporated Los Angeles County.

\*Per Los Angeles County Code § 11.35.070(E), tobacco retailers operating in unincorporated areas of Los Angeles County are **not permitted** to sell any flavored tobacco products, including those exempted by state law.
