## TB Clearance Process for Parent and School Volunteers

Answer the TB Risk Assessment questions with a licensed medical provider of your own or at your school





If "no TB risk identified" – on the TB
Risk Assessment questions, your school
designee will fill out a TB Clearance
Form

If you answered "yes" on any of the questions on the TB Risk Assessment – go to your medical provider who will order a TB skin or blood test (IGRA)



If you do not have a healthcare provider or insurance, go to the nearest <u>Public Health Immunization</u>

<u>Clinic</u> or a <u>My Health LA Community</u>

<u>clinic</u>





People with a positive TB skin or blood test need a chest x-ray to determine that they are not contagious. The doctor will complete the evaluation, may direct you for treatment, and can complete the TB Clearance form.

If your TB skin or blood test is negative – your doctor can complete the <u>TB Clearance</u> <u>Form</u>





Take the completed <u>TB Clearance</u> <u>Form</u> to your school nurse or other designated school official
